



Club Person of The Year Award

Each year, the Clarence Coast Dragon Boat Club Inc (CCDBC), has many people who contribute their time and resources to helping the club. These contributions are highly valued and whilst we cannot always recognise everyone's efforts, we do attempt to recognise some of the more significant contributions by way of our **Club Person of The Year** award.

The **Club Person of The Year** award seeks to recognise the contribution of a person who has worked tirelessly throughout the season, without the expectation of recognition and for no financial or personal gain, for the overall benefit of the club and its members. The club member may also have made a positive difference to any individual member's paddling year, by being friendly and welcoming and helping a new member settle into the club or for positive contributions to the sport and the crew.

This person does not have to be an office bearer or have a specific job, nor do they need to be a member. No minimum years of service are required to be eligible for nomination for this award.

Choosing Club Person of The Year

Aim

The purpose of this award is to acknowledge outstanding individuals who have shown dedication, commitment and made a significant contribution to our Club. The award can be presented annually at the AGM.

Criteria

- Financial/social member
- Demonstrates club values
- The Club Person of the Year is someone who has made a REAL difference to the Club in that time.

Nominations must be submitted to Clarence Coast Dragon Boat Club Secretary or Board member for the Board meeting prior to the AGM

Allocation

The Board will consider all submissions and select the nomination which most closely meets the above criteria. If no nominations are received, the award does not have to be granted.

Decisions made by the Board are final and no appeals will be entered into.

The successful recipient will have their name and the year it has been granted engraved on the perpetual trophy.
